

Role of the Junior Service Leader

Youth members attending the Jamboree as a Junior Service Leader are required to participate in a service role and work each day in their allocated activity. Junior Service Leaders will receive two (2) days off (not consecutive) during the Jamboree.

Selection Criteria

1. Registered as a Venturer Scout for a minimum of one year and be at least 16 years of age at the beginning of the Jamboree, and no more than 18 years by the end of the Jamboree.
2. Achieved the Venturing Skills Award.
3. Completed the Unit Management Course and the Leadership Course or a minimum of one activity under each Activity Area.
4. Recommended by both Unit Council and Venturer Leader as being of excellent character and able to provide a role model to Scouts.
5. Have a high level of communication skills.
6. Have a wide experience of Venturer activities.
7. Have a thorough knowledge of the Venturer Award Scheme.
8. Have a desire to provide service to Scouts.

Venturer Award Scheme

Participation as a Junior Service Leader at the Jamboree may in some cases assist in completing an aspect of the Award Scheme. This must have prior approval through Unit and District channels.
